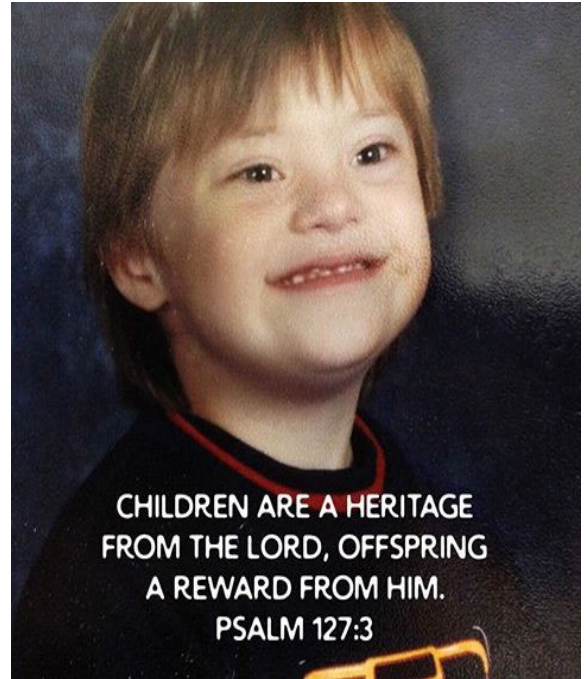
**PARTY!!** The Religious Education Program is having a **pizza and ice cream party** to celebrate the end of another year of faith

CHAPTER THREE—I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY SPIRIT  
PART ONE—PROFESSION OF FAITH

*Mary, Mother of Christ, Mother of the Church*

*197. How does the Virgin Mary help the Church?*

After the Ascension of her Son, the Virgin Mary aided the beginnings of the Church with her prayers. Even after her Assumption into heaven, she continues to intercede for her children, to be a model of faith and charity for all, and to exercise over them a salutary influence deriving from the superabundant merits of Christ. The faithful see in Mary an image and an anticipation of her resurrection that awaits them and they invoke her as advocate, helper, benefactress and mediatrix.
