DAY TRIP TO THE SHRINE OF THE MOST BLESSED SACRAMENT St. Jude Parish and Fr. Jones are offering the opportunity to go on a day trip (pilgrimage) to the Shrine of the Most Blessed Sacrament in Hanceville, AL. This mini pilgrimage will take us to one of the most beautiful places in the United States—the monastery and grounds of the Poor Clare nuns just north of Birmingham. The Shrine is built in imitation of the Basilica of St. Francis in Assisi, Italy, and is home to a life-sized replica of the grotto at Lourdes, France where the Blessed Virgin appeared to St. Bernadette; a life-sized Nativity scene; the largest Catholic book store and gift shop in Alabama; a museum of Eucharistic miracles; the largest monstrance in North America (8 ft tall!); and one of the most beautiful churches you will ever step foot inside of! Lunch and Mass will be provided!

When: Saturday, August 13th

TIME: Meet at St. Jude parking lot at 8am and board the Charter bus for Hanceville. We will return to St. Jude by 6pm.

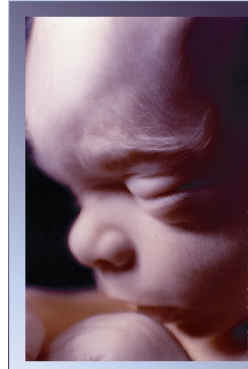
FOOD: Lunch is provided

WHO: Anyone is welcome—does not have to be a St. Jude parishioner

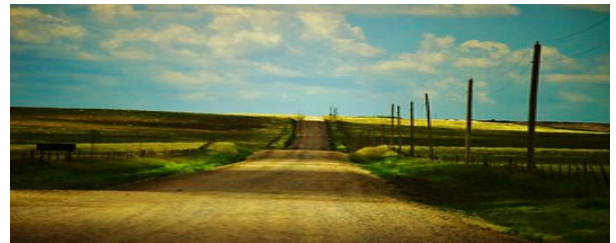
