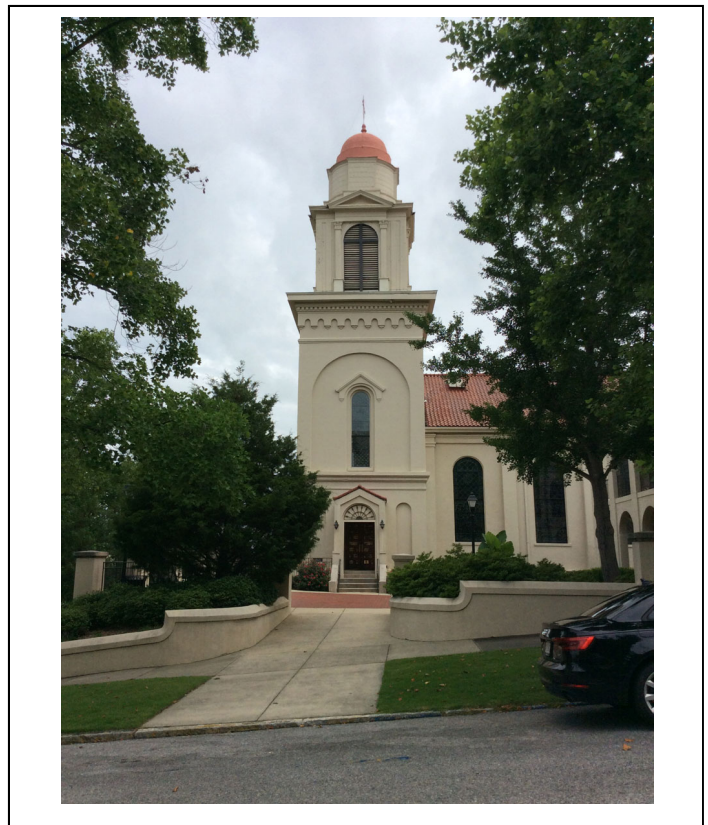

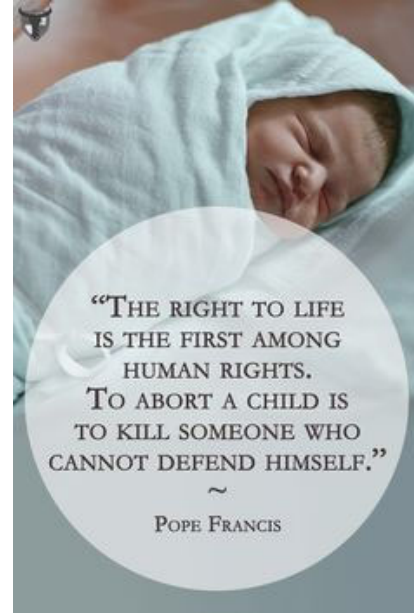
Mary, Mother of Christ, Mother of the Church
