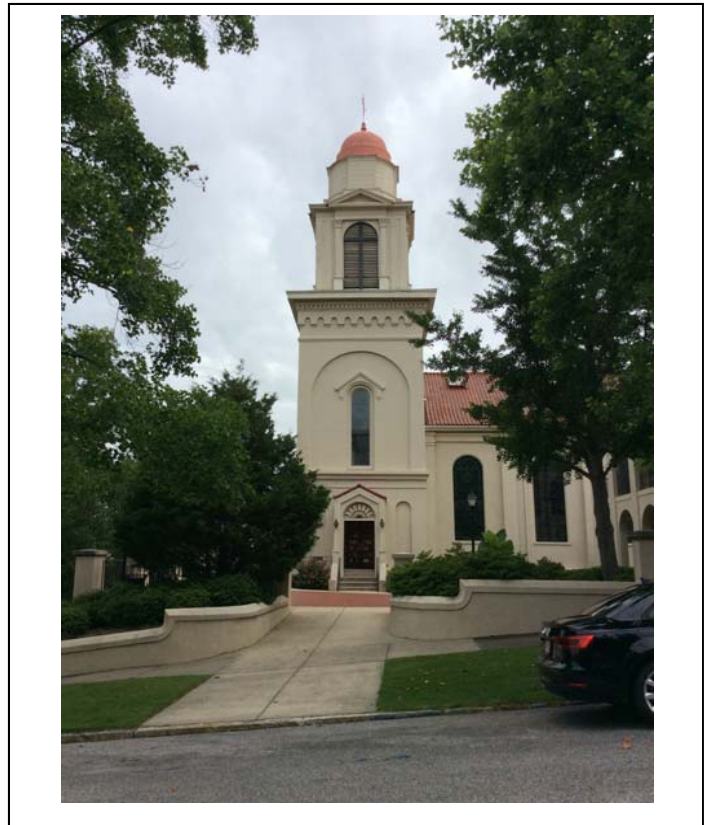

226. *What is the link between the sacraments and the Church?*

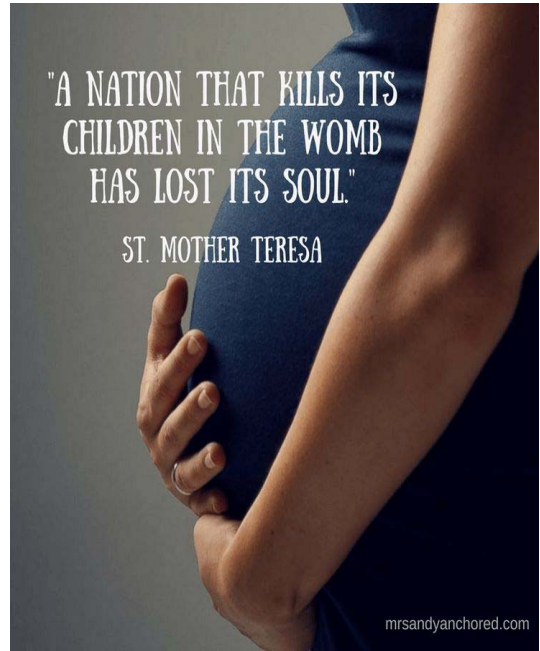
