### COMPENDIUM OF THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

PART TWO—THE CELEBRATION OF THE CHRISTIAN MYSTERY

CHAPTER ONE —THE PASCHAL MYSTERY IN THE AGE OF THE CHURCH

229. *Why are the sacraments efficacious?*

The Sacraments are efficacious *ex opera operato* (“by the very fact that the sacramental action is performed”) because it is Christ who acts in the sacraments and communicates the grace they signify. The efficacy of the sacraments does not depend upon the personal holiness of the minister. However, the fruits of the sacraments do depend on the dispositions of the one who receives them.
