

PART TWO—THE CELEBRATION OF THE CHRISTIAN MYSTERY

CHAPTER ONE — THE PASCHAL MYSTERY IN THE AGE OF THE CHURCH

233. Who celebrates the heavenly liturgy?

The heavenly liturgy is celebrated by the angels, by the saints of the Old and New Testament, particularly the Mother of God, by the Apostles, by the martyrs, and by the "great multitude, which no one could count, from every nation, race, people, and tongue." (Revelation 7:9). When we celebrate the mystery of our salvation in the sacraments we participate in this eternal liturgy.

EVERY FRIDAY DURING LENT, we will have Stations of the Cross after the 12:10 PM Mass and at 6 PM followed by a Soup Supper and a movie.
