

#### Easter Message from Fr. Maria

Dear Parishioners of St. Peter,

Christ is Risen! Alleluia! Alleluia! Happy Easter! Thank you for your presence and prayers as we celebrate this special feast. We celebrate the beautiful gift of life that God has blessed each of us with.

In the Gospel of Matthew we read how an angel appeared to the women at the tomb early that first Easter morning.
