



COMPENDIUM OF THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

PART TWO—THE CELEBRATION OF THE CHRISTIAN MYSTERY

CHAPTER ONE —THE PASCHAL MYSTERY IN THE AGE OF THE CHURCH

What are the criteria for the proper use of singing and music in liturgical celebrations?

Since song and music are closely connected with liturgical action they must respect the following criteria. They should conform to Catholic doctrine in their texts, drawn preferably from Sacred Scripture and liturgical sources. They should be a beautiful expression of prayer. The music should be of high quality. Song and music should encourage the participation of the liturgical assembly. They should express the cultural richness of the People of God and the sacred and solemn character of the celebration. "He who sings, prays twice" (Saint Augustine).
