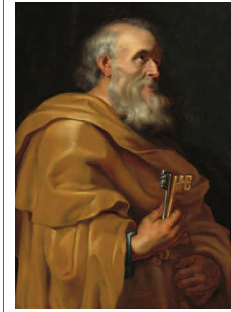

SECOND COLLECTIONS IN OCTOBER OCTOBER 22ND—PROPGATION OF THE FAITH

WORK ON THE BELL TOWER is set to begin, Monday, October 9th. The Holy Doors will be closed on the 9th, and will remain closed for the duration of the construction. The front doors will be accessible. Also, you may not enter the vestibule anytime during the construction process. There will be **NO** street parking on Adams Avenue during the week. There will be **NO** parking in the lot by the school building. On the weekend, parking will be available in the court house parking lot across the street from the Church or you can park in the AT&T lot located on McDonough Street. If you use the nursery, you will have to go in the door located across from the carport and continue on to the nursery. This construction will likely take 3 months to complete, so this will be an adjustment, but the end result will be well worth it.
