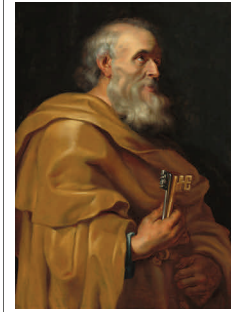
The topic will be, "Constantine" and the talk will be given by Gary Parker. Refreshments will be served afterwards.
