- Support of the parish through time, talent & treasures

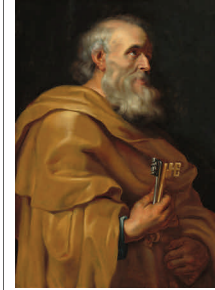

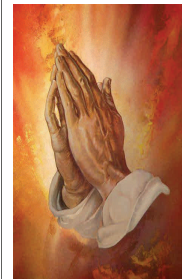
