Active Membership is determined by:

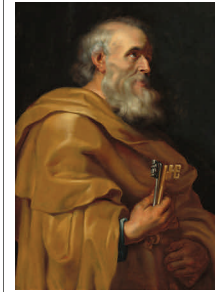
