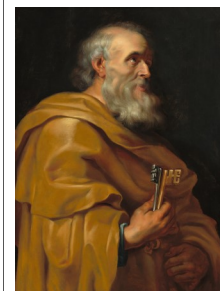


NEW PARISHIONERS
