



DURING LENT THIS YEAR, please join us in the parish hall to learn and reflect on the art of Pysanky Egg decorating. Pysanky eggs are traditional Ukrainian Easter eggs decorated using a wax-resist (batik) method. Pysanky eggs are rich in symbolism, with traditional motifs representing nature, prosperity, protection, and renewal. Historically, they were believed to have protective powers and were often given as gifts. The tradition has been passed down through generations and remains an important cultural and artistic practice in Eastern Europe. The last date we will be in the parish hall is April 12 from 9 AM to 12 Noon. All

materials will be supplied (including eggs). Participants are just asked to bring paper towels and patience.

THIS JUBILEE YEAR is designated as a Year of Hope. Indeed, hope is a necessary virtue in a land marked by cycles of violence and relative calm. Gaza itself has been reduced to rubble. Missiles have hit many other places as well. People across the region are tasked with rebuilding homes, schools, hospitals, and even churches. Many of our faithful earn their living from pilgrimages. Still repaying debts from the pandemic shutdown, they found themselves soon assaulted by war. Now, already in debt, many have again lost jobs. Fear and despair have driven many Christians to leave the Holly Land: over the past century, Christians have gone from 23% to less than 2% of the population. And more than 90 Christian families have already left Bethlehem since October 7, having lost hope in a good future for then in the land where Jesus and the Church were born.
