

PALM SUNDAY, CELEBRATED BY CHRISTIANS ON THE SUNDAY BEFORE EASTER, commemorates Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem, where he was greeted by crowds waving palm branches, marking the beginning of Holy Week and the events leading to his crucifixion. The Gospels describe Jesus entering Jerusalem riding a donkey, fulfilling a prophecy in Zechariah 9:9, and being greeted by a jubilant crowd who spread palm branches and their cloaks on the road, shouting "Hosanna". Palm branches symbolize victory, peace, and triumph, reflecting the crowds' initial enthusiasm for Jesus as a king. Many Christian denominations observe Palm Sunday with processions, hymns, and readings from the Bible, often distributing palm branches to the congregation. Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week, a period of solemn reflection and remembrance of Jesus' suffering, death, and resurrection. Palm Sunday is also known as Passion Sunday, referring to the story of Jesus' suffering and crucifixion, which is read during the service. Palm Sunday serves as a reminder of both the initial welcome Jesus received and the suffering and sacrifice that would follow, highlighting the themes of humility, kingship, and salvation.
